European Pensions Consultancy of the Year: Lane Clark & Peacock



The European Pensions Consultancy of the Year award is given to the pensions consultancy firm that the judges believe has delivered outstanding service to its pension fund clients in the last year; has shown a dedication to the delivery of pension scheme consultancy in its respective markets; has demonstrated a superior understanding of the market's needs; and has shown a commitment to helping clients through the pensions maze.

This year's well deserved winner was LCP (Lane Clark & Peacock) which was shortlisted alongside some of the biggest and most established pension consultancy firms in the pensions sphere.

LCP impressed the judges with the significant in-roads it has made into the European pensions space in the last

year; coupled with its innovation, excellence and commitment to its clients in the European pensions arena.

The judges were particularly impressed by what LCP has achieved in relation to raising the issue of pensions as a key cross-border strategic issue for multinationals.

LCP is a specialist European pensions adviser, with 81 partners and over 500 staff in five European countries (UK, Switzerland, Belgium, the Netherlands and Ireland).

Its innovative ideas and independent, partner-led approach resulted in significant business wins and 20% revenue growth in 2008/09.

During 2009, LCP challenged its European clients to redefine their pensions strategy and explore options

for reducing risk in the challenging economic environment. This approach allowed them to develop innovative services across new locations, Belgium, the Netherlands and Ireland, for some of Europe's largest pension funds.

LCP launched a new Swiss investment consulting subsidiary, LCP Asalis, in 2009, while this period also saw the first full year contribution from LCP offices in both Ireland and the Netherlands.

Lane Clark & Peacock has clearly established itself in some of the biggest and most competitive European pensions markets, and has demonstrated its commitment and dedication to improving excellence in Europe's pensions space.
